Thank-you to all the harriers who took part - 26 out of the 72 finishers were harriers. Thanks also to all those who helped especially Greg Rowson for marking the course, and Pauline Lynch, Ray Eagle and Vicky Keddie for officiating.

We hope to hold the 'Rainow Hill Race' next year under FRA rules on Thursday 9th July and look forward to seeing you there.
