
3. Welcome to new committee members

6. Finance [MG]

- Coaching costs have significantly increased to £3900. This will be an ongoing cost due to the recent UKA/EA changes in First Aid requirements.

- We have been asked by Macclesfield Athletics Development Fund [MADF] committee, to consider releasing funds to them relating to track profit from previous year[s].

The committee discussed this request and will not be releasing any funds at this time due to :-

- Lack of a clear MADF plan for the funds
- Given our increased and ongoing costs at this time and in the future.
