1. Previous minutes/actions: approved.

2. Welfare & First Aid reporting

a. Outstanding previous issue now completed. Nothing further to report.

3. Finance and Membership [MG]

a. Club accounts:

b. We are due to receive payment for volunteers at the half marathon 26 October, which will be donated to the MND fund. Likely to be in the region of 20-25 volunteers/

4. Kit update [RG]

a. Sales of vests, hoodies and T-shirts continue as planned via DP Sports directly.

Crop tops from Zeon Sports have arrived and will be sold directly to members initially, thereafter will go on the DP Sports website.

SOAR vests for marathon runners are in design, and an order will go in October for January delivery. Run North West will sell these directly to members either online or they can be tried on in their shop in Wilmslow. There is no financial risk to the club in terms of minimum orders, Run North West will order and sell these at cost to our members as a gesture of community running spirit! RG is managing the process from Harriers side, and we will remind members of the option to purchase in January once they arrive in store.

5. Section Updates

a. Road Running [OM]

c. Cross Country [EL]

d. Fell Running [TW]
